

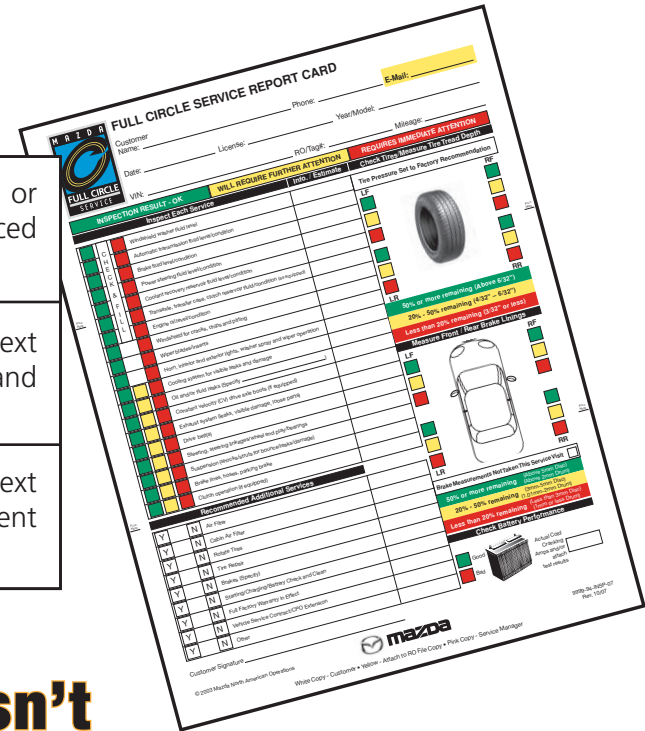
The Mazda Full Circle Service Experience

Every time you visit the service department of a Mazda dealership you will receive something that you may not expect - a complimentary Full Circle Service Inspection and Report Card. This provides the peace-of-mind that your vehicle is performing as designed. Only Mazda dealerships feature tools and equipment designed just for your Mazda, as well as Mazda Service Professionals, Genuine Mazda Parts and Accessories, and Value Products by Mazda.

With the Mazda Full Circle Service Report Card, it's easy to interpret the results:

	Items that are in “good” condition — they do not show evidence of unusual or significant wear. Green is also used for items that have been repaired or replaced during this visit.
	Items that are wearing significantly, but are not likely to fail before the next scheduled maintenance interval. Yellow condition indicates normal wear and tear.
	Items that require immediate attention or will likely wear out before the next maintenance interval. In this case, we are recommending immediate replacement or repair.

TIRES

Mazda recommends inspecting your tires a minimum of once a month, when refueling or during other convenient times. Look for stones, glass, nails, or other imbedded objects, as well as cuts, or other damage. Also remember to rotate your tires as recommended (Refer to your Owner's Manual for details), and replace any tire when less than 3/32" of tread depth remains.



When your tires are ready to be replaced, your Mazda should be refitted with Original Equipment tires to maintain the same performance, including braking, handling, hydroplaning-resistance, and tread life.

BRAKES

To keep brake performance at its optimum level, an inspection **every six months** is recommended. Because brake pads and shoes are hidden behind the wheels and calipers or drums, you cannot visually check how they're worn. See your authorized Mazda dealer for a brake inspection today.



When your brake pads or shoes are in need of replacement, request Genuine Mazda brakes or Value Products by Mazda brakes. Genuine Mazda Brakes and Value Products by Mazda brakes are designed to perform best for specific Mazda models, and are constantly updated to ensure they're the highest quality brakes available.

BATTERIES

While every Mazda engine is designed to be powerful, they're still dependent on a reliable, powerful battery to get started.
